I want to express my appreciation for the people who have served on the Children & Youth Transition Team. Thank you: Susan Hellings, Larry Martin, Laura Morris, Alden Pinkham, Cindy Bryant, Arlyn Burgess, and Megan Sharp. In last week's newsletter, there was a teaser update that hinted at the team's recommendations "for future staffing." Although I have not been involved in the team's work, I can attest to their diligence in listening to the parents, youth, and children. The team considered how we can best minister to these vital constituencies in our congregation, and I want to echo the call from last week's newsletter for us to pray for their work.

Just like when I write an op-ed for <u>Baptist News Global</u>, I am sharing my opinion about their work here. Here's my opinion: We are a congregational body. God speaks through all of us. As a congregational body, we make decisions together. Sometimes we make good and fruitful decisions that bless the church. Other times, we learn from our decisions. Each new day, we continue following where God leads.

If the transition team's recommendation is for additional staffing, then we need to ask, first, is this what God is calling our church to do? If the answer is yes, then God will show us a path forward. If the answer is no, then we need to go back to the drawing board. Second, if this is

what God is calling us to do, then how does God want us to do it? Third, are we prepared to invest in God's future? There are more questions we can ask, and for any recommendation, there will be details to work out. Still, the first question must remain: Is the team's recommendation what God is calling our church to do? Keep in mind that God might be calling us out of our comfort zone.

The Bible is full of God calling people out of their comfort zones. When God called Abram (Genesis 12), God didn't say where he was supposed to go. When God called Moses (Exodus 3 -4), Moses came up with a bunch of reasons why he couldn't go. When God commissioned Joshua to succeed Moses, Joshua needed reassuring. "Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened or dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go" (Joshua 1:9). Esther risked her life to save her people (Esther 4). When Jesus called Peter to step out of the boat and walk on water, this was new territory for Peter (Matthew 14:29). This list could go on.


When we consider the report from the Children & Youth Transition Team, we first ask if their report is what God is calling us to do. If so, everything else will fall into place.


Thanks to the kindness and generosity of this church the following was done with this year's donations to *Dinner With Andrew*.
