NWATCH Invitation & Then What?

In this space, I've written about creating an invitational culture before (e.g. here). Because of our location, we are blessed with lots of people checking out the church. I spoke with a man on Sunday who works in the Battle Building. He is a member of another church, but when he must work on a Sunday, he slips out of work at 11am to join us for worship. We are his local home away from home. We often have people join us in worship who are visiting Charlottesville. Recently, there was a family in worship from Texas. When I spoke to them before the service, I guessed that it was a college visit for the daughter. However, they explained that they were not on a college visit. They were in Charlottesville visiting friends at the Army JAG School. After worship, the family thanked me for such a meaningful experience.

These two examples are the tip of the iceberg of people who come through our doors. The question for those of us who are active in the life of the church is: how can we (a) make them feel welcome, and (b) create an experience they will want to have again. And the answer to this question is that it takes all of us.

Last Sunday, we had over a dozen students stay for the college bagel brunch. This doesn't include the students who had other plans and couldn't stay. However, the successful rate of students who stayed reflects several variables. First, Megan's enthusiasm for this ministry is contagious. Second, Laura Morris gave a warm welcome and

After someone shows up, how do we draw them into UBC life? There are some easy steps that all of us can do. (1) Learn their name. Regardless of the age, where the person is from, or how they are dressed, learn their name. (2) Remember it, and (3), call them by name when you see them again. If they forgot your name, that's okay. Tell them your name again and tell the person how happy you are that they are here. (4) Listen carefully, and if you find any clues about what part of UBC life they might find life giving, don't keep it a secret.
